

Faculty Position in Cryospheric Science at Stanford University

We invite applications for a tenure-track faculty position in the Department of Geophysics (<https://earth.stanford.edu/geophysics>) in the broadly defined field of cryospheric science. The appointment will be at the junior level (Assistant or untenured Associate Professor). We are most interested in scientists addressing the dynamics of the cryosphere through geophysical observations and/or theoretical/computational models. Areas of particular interest include, but are not limited to, polar ice sheets, permafrost, mountain glaciers, sea level rise, ice/ocean or ice/atmosphere interactions, and climate system feedbacks.

The successful candidate will be expected to develop a world-class independent program of research, have a strong commitment to both graduate and undergraduate teaching, and initiate and sustain research collaborations across disciplines. A doctorate is required at the time of appointment.

Applications should include a cover letter, curriculum vita, a statement of research and teaching interests, three recent publications, and the names and email addresses of three individuals from whom the search committee can request letters of reference.
